



# Knock Knock Jokes



A knock knock joke is a call and response joke. This means that it is a back and forth joke with another person. A knock knock joke usually has five lines.

  
Person 1

“Knock, knock?”

  
Person 2

“Who’s there?”

  
Person 1

“*word*”

  
Person 2

“*word* who?”

  
Person 1

“*word* + **pun**”

Knock knock jokes have a puns at the end. A **pun** is a way to use words that is funny. In a knock knock joke, the pun is using the first word in an unexpected way. See this example:

  
Person 1

“Knock, knock?”  

  
Person 2

“Who’s there?” 

  
Person 1

“Police” 

  
Person 2

“Police who?” 

  
Person 1

“Police hurry with that water. I’m thirsty!”

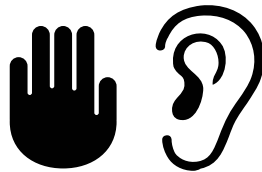


This joke is funny because “**police**” sounds like “**please**”.  
That is the pun.

When telling any jokes, especially knock knock jokes, timing is very important. This means it is best to wait a second or two after the other person responds. Listen for their response, then count “1,2” in your head before saying your next line.



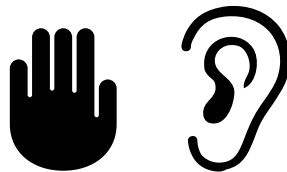
“Knock, knock?”

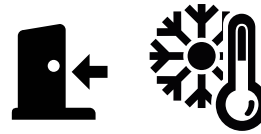
