







I Spy Colors

Purpose: Generalize the skill of color sorting by helping students recognize and describe the colors in their environment.

Directions:

1. Write the word or draw in each color that you want your student to find on a sticky note.
2. Have your student use the labels to identify objects of different colors in the environment.

Items Needed

- Sticky Notes (4) 
- Colored Pencils/Markers 
- Color Dictionary (optional)  

Ideas For Adapting

Easier:

- Move the objects so that they are all located near each other or in a space that is clearly designated with boundaries
- Write the color word on each label in the same color

Harder:

- After learning this activity in the class room, try having your student complete it in the community
- Race the clock to see how quickly your student can find all of the colors
